The Main Street Center, formerly known as the Senior Citizens Center, just completed year two of a three/four year, 5-phase renovation project with the assistance of the Dakota Hospital Foundation and matching funds from community members. We are very excited about the new work. The reason for this comprehensive project is to modernize the Center with improvements to the electricity and plumbing infrastructure and to give the Center a fresh look. Since project implementation, the first three phases have been completed. Much of the labor has been provided by members of the Center who have worked countless hours and have drawn on their prior professional experience. The Center wouldn't be this far without their work.

The attached plan shows the work completed and the work planned for 2014/15 .

It should also be noted that while this major renovation is underway the Main Street Center continues to operate on a daily basis and constantly provides a welcoming and comfortable environment for many kinds of activities enjoyed by its members.

Through aggressive fund raising and the generosity of the Vermillion community, the Center met Years I and II matching funds to qualify for the continued support of the local Dakota Hospital Foundation grant .
